- I. The Power of the Bible
 - A. What is the Bible like?
 - 1. The Bible is **Infallible** (Psa. 19:7).
 - 2. The Bible is Inerrant (Prov. 30:5-6).
 - 3. The Bible is **Complete** (Rev. 22:18-19).
 - 4. The Bible is Authoritative (Isa. 1:2; John 8:30-31).
 - 5. The Bible is **Sufficient** (2 Tim. 3:15-17; James 1:21b, 25).
 - 6. The Bible is **Effective** (Isa. 55:11; 1 The. 1:5).
 - 7. The Bible is **Determinative** (John 8:47; 12:48).
 - B. Why should I study the Bible?
 - 1. It is the source of **TRUTH** (John 17:17). *Every time we pick up the Bible we pick up the truth!*
 - 2. It is the source of **HAPPINESS** (Psa. 19:8; Luke 11:28). *The joy comes from obeying the word.*
 - 3. It is the source of **VICTORY** (Psa. 119:11; Eph. 6:17). Only the word can prevent us from sin.
 - 4. It is the source of **GROWTH** (1 Pet. 2:1-2; 2 Pet. 3:18). Study is the only way to spiritually grow.
 - 5. It is the source of **POWER** (Heb. 4:12; Rom. 1:16; 2 Tim. 1:7-8). God's power is available to us!
 - 6. It is the source of **GUIDANCE** (Psa. 119:105). God's will is easy to find; it's right in His book!
 - C. How Should I Respond to the Bible?
 - 1. Believe it (Rom. 10:17; cf. John 6:67-69).
 - 2. Honor it (cf. Job 23:12; Psa. 138:2).
 - 3. Love it (Psa. 119:97; 19:7-10).
 - 4. Obey it (1 John 2:5; John 14:15; 15:14).
 - 5. Fight for it (Jude 3).
 - 6. Preach it (2 Tim. 4:2; Mark 16:15-16).
 - 7. Study it (2 Tim. 2:15).
